LOCAL LAW NUMBER 1 OF 2005
OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY

A local law establishing a date for the meetings of the Board of Assessment
Review to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Granby as follows:

1. Purpose: The Town of Granby in the County of Oswego, New York, employs an Assessor who is at the same time employed by another assessing unit.

Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 512(1-a) of the Real Property Tax Law, the Town of Granby desires to establish a date for the meetings of the Board of Assessment Review other than that provided for in Section 512(1) of the Real Property Tax Law.
2. Hearing Complaints: Beginning on the second Wednesday after the fourth Tuesday of May, and so many days thereafter as the Board of Assessment Review deems necessary, such Board shall meet to hear complaints in relation to assessments.
3. This local law supercedes and in is the place of the date for the hearing of complaints set forth in Section 512(1) of the Real Property Tax Law.
4. This local law shall become effective upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State and in the office of the state board of real property services.

RESOLUTION

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Granby, New York, held at the Town Hall on March 9, 2005, the following Resolution was moved and adopted:

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the Town of Granby adopt a Local Law establishing a date for the meetings of the Board of Assessment Review to hear complaints in relation to assessments; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 9, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. before the Town Board to obtain comment from the residents of the Town regarding the proposal, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that enacting a Local Law establishing a date for the meetings of the Board of Assessment Review to hear complaints in relation to assessments would be in the best interests of the Town.

NOW, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Town of Granby Town Board adopt Local Law Number 1 of 2005, establishing a date for the meetings of the Board of Assessment Review to hear complaints in relation to assessments; and it is further

RESOLVED that Local Law Number 1 of 2005 shall take effect upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State and in the office of the state board of real property services.
