LOCAL LAW NUMBER 1 OF 2001 OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY

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A local law permitting the appointment of non-electors of the Town of Granby as Town Constables.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Granby as follows:

- The eligibility requirements for the position of Town Constable which may be in effect on the date of adoption of this local law are amended to provide that the Town Board is permitted to appoint as Town Constables for the Town of Granby individuals who are not electors of the Town.
- 2. The provisions of this local law shall supercede any inconsistent laws, rules and regulations, including, but not necessarily limited to, the provisions contained in sections 20(1)(b) and 23(1) of New York State Town Law.
- This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
