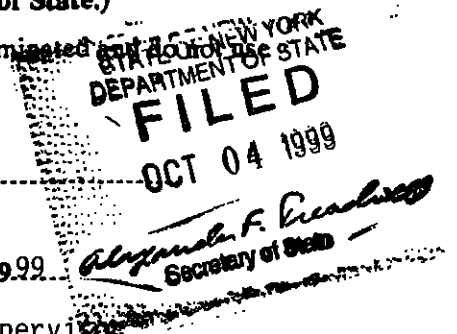

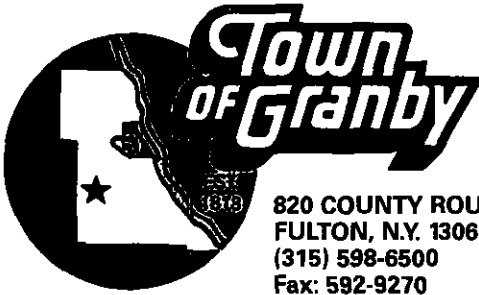

**LOCAL LAW NUMBER 1 OF 1999, OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY, N.Y.**

**A LOCAL LAW REVISING THE SALARY OF THE SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY FOR A LIMITED TIME.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION ONE. Pursuant to Town Law section 27, the annual salary of the Supervisor of the Town of Granby is changed to Twenty-five Thousand, Three Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,300.00).

SECTION TWO. The change to the salary of the Supervisor as provided herein shall expire on midnight, December 31, 1999.

SECTION THREE. Any individual appointed to the position of Supervisor of the Town of Granby during 1999 and compensated as provided in this Local Law shall be appointed as a full-time employee of the Town of Granby, exercising such duties and responsibilities as specified in the Town Law of the State of New York.

SECTION FOUR. The total amount to be expended by the Town of Granby on payroll for all employees of the Supervisor's Office during the 1999 fiscal year shall not exceed the amount budgeted to be spent on such purposes during 1999.

SECTION FIVE. This Local Law shall be subject to permissive referendum, and shall take effect as soon as legally permissible.
