Local Law #3-2001

Resolution #47-2001 was made by Councilor Arnold, seconded by Councilor Haggerty to adopt Local Law #3-2001 as follows:

Whereas, it has been proposed that the Town of Granby adopt a Local Law amending the Zoning Ordinance and the Subdivision Regulations of the Town of Granby, to transfer authority over the granting of Special Use Permits from the Zoning Board of Appeals to the Planning Board; and

Whereas, public hearings were held on August 8 & August 22, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. before the Town Board to obtain comment from the residents of the Town regarding the proposal; and

Whereas, the Town Board has determined that enacting a Local Law amending the Zoning Ordinance and the Subdivision Regulations of the Town of Granby, to transfer authority over the granting of Special Use Permits from the Zoning Board of Appeals to the Planning Board would be in the best interest of the Town;

Now, be it RESOLVED that the Town of Granby Town Board hereby enacts a Local Law amending the Zoning Ordinance and the Subdivision regulations of the Town of Granby, to transfer authority over the granting of Special Use Permits from the Zoning Board of Appeals to the Planning Board.
