CALL TO ORDER

REPORTS FROM DEPARTMENTS

Town Clerk/Tax Collector – Total revenue for November was \$3,029.20. A check in the amount of \$77.00 went to the New York State Department of Ag & Markets for the spay/neuter program. A check in the amount of \$2,921.96 was given to the Supervisor and \$30.24 went to the DEC for licensing.

Justice – The printer has been plugged in by Justice Doyle after two months in the box. It does not work at this time.

Planning Board – They have a couple of open things going on. They have a family that wants to do homesteading. There will be a Public Hearing for this after the first of the year. They have also been working with the people from Davidson's on the car wash application.
