CALL TO ORDER

Deputy Supervisor Crego called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. Present for the **roll call** were Deputy Supervisor Jane Crego, Councilors Rodney DeLong, Sandra Farrands, Marianne Ingerson and Irene Wiestner. Supervisor John Snow, Jr. was not present. Highway Superintendent Duncan was also present. There were no residents in attendance.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Deputy Supervisor Crego read a letter sent to Supervisor Snow, Jr. by the NYS DOT. It stated that they will be removing the ditches on State Route 48 between County Line Road and Windemere Drive. They will also be asking the New York State Police and the Sherriff's Department to increase speed enforcement in that area.

Supervisor Snow, Jr. sent the Board information about Evolis Radar Speed Sign equipment. Councilor Ingerson stated it would be a good idea. She sees them as a benefit in other communities and believes they do work. The Board would like to have further discussion with Supervisor Snow, Jr. regarding the placement of the signs.

Supervisor Snow, Jr. would like to attend the GFOA Intensive Accounting and Reporting training in June. Our Bond Council is recommending that we have a comprehensive financial report completed each year. He feels he would be able to complete that report if he had the training and that would be a benefit to the Town's financial status.
