CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Snow, Jr. called the meeting to order at 6:01 P.M. Present for the **roll call** were Supervisor John Snow, Jr., Councilors Rodney DeLong, Sandara Farrands, Marianne Ingerson and Irene Wiestner. Deputy Supervisor/Planning Board Chairperson Jane Crego was also present. There were no residents in attendance.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilor DeLong made a motion, seconded by Councilor Ingerson to enter Executive Session to discuss labor negotiations with the Teamsters Union, all were in favor, none opposed.

The Board entered Executive Session at 6:02 P.M.

Councilor Farrands made a motion, seconded by Councilor Wiestner to reconvene the meeting, all were in favor, none opposed.

The meeting was reconvened at 6:57 P.M.

Councilor DeLong made a motion, seconded by Councilor Wiestner to enter Executive Session for legal discussion pertaining to cases that the Town may be involved in, all were in favor, none opposed.
